Race 1 2-1-6

W C Marys Buddy – Little filly showed some step leading up and into the Dewar and then ran into some bad luck with breaking in stride. Has a clean line under her belt, one that none of her rivals have been able to match.

Beach Cloud – The Blue Knight and the rail means one thing, this colt will be forwardly placed and for that reason we see him as a must use in the ticket.

Sandys Shore – We thought about putting the rest of them on a dart board and throwing one, but instead we landed on this trotting bred pacer who continue to progress with every start.

Race 2 3-2-5

Woodmere Rio – She has already made that tough first life time venture and she did it by returning back to the winners enclosure – The veteran Earl Smith always has them on their toes and ready to rock at first asking, for that reason she gets our respect at top call.

Therealdeal – By no means should anyone overlook this filly because she looks to have a lot of get up and go in her set of tools, great last quarter in her qualifier and we know this trainer/driver combo knows how to find the winner circle.

Girl With Attitude – From the first crop Varadero – this filly showed some convincing ability in her qualifier that shows us she is worth throwing in the ticket in this small field.

Race 3 5-3-2

Jinglewriter – This mare continues to drop down the class ladder and on paper looks like the one to beat. With two wins under her belt heading into this race and the chance for Adam to have a big week, she could and should add to his totals.

Shouldabeenaclown – Jumped up in class her last start and the step up was just a little too much, with a good post to work with at a level she has been on the edges from bad posts, she should be better.

Fleurje – Another class dropping mare that we see as a must use even with her inconsistency. She shows some miles that would lead you to believe she is the one to beat and others that make you wonder if she'll hit the ticket. Hope the right mare shows up today.

Race 4 1-2-6

Something Reel – Hard to get a read off of this filly without seeing her qualifier – She got beat by a lot but does have inside control and the best qualifying time to date.

Howmac Margarita – Like that this little filly has some more experience under her belt then her competition and that she has Kenny at the helm.

Fern Hill Delight – Tracked along behind some really nice fillies in her first outing in Charlottetown and that trip and her last quarter is the reason we'll use her as part of the ticket.

Race 5 1-4-3

Shadows Mystery – This mare has had an unfortunate string of bad luck but after last week, the class drop and the post she drew it looks like things could be starting to turn in her favor. This mare could turn in a big one tonight!

Bettim Vicky – She dropped down to the bottom of the barrel and did she ever regain her confidence and her touch, she does loose Campbell today however and jump up a level.

Anzula – If you look at her lines this is where this is the class where this little mare does her best work. She'll hook back up with Dowling from an inside post at her level so she is a must use.

Best Bet – Shadows Mystery

Race 6 5-2-4

Windemere Pay Day – All things look pretty equal in here, what one has for check marks another one doesn't offer and vice versa. She has the best qualifying time but again we don't know much about this filly.

Rebels Paradise – We've become a little familiar with this filly having caught her train a few miles in Charlottetown, as she learns the sport a little more this filly should only get better.

Ambey Regal Rose – She looks to have gone her own qualifying mile on July 5, and with that kicked home with the best last quarter on the page.

Race 7 2-6-1

Bro dys Leona – This is about as tough as 851 mares as you will see in the province this season, a couple show racing the Open Mares and one shows racing the top fillies in the region. This mare has been such a solid raceway mare over the last number of years, it would be hard to see her get beat at this level twice in a row.

Julep Hanover – Another class dropping mare, if she had a better post to work with there would be no reason to not have her at the top of the ticket, especially after that trip she shows last week.

Good Luck Kathy – She didn't quite come back into the form that she showed last season. If Smith can get this mare away on the right foot, he may not let them have it their way. Either way, she is in the ticket no matter the scenario for us.

Race 8 2-4-1

Unapologetically – Say that one three times fast – well you may have to get used to it – another first crop Varadero who shows that she has a great set of tools in her repertoire, you may remember her half-sister – Filly Forty Seven – we're not saying that she is her but she does have most of the same tools.

Howmac Sabrina – Another first crop here in Malicious – and we absolutely love what his off springs have showed to this point, now it is time to put up because the money is down. This filly had a dandy looking trip in her first charted trip with a wicked closing quarter! No doubt our top two selections shall hook up at some point.

Dustylanebukinfuty – The Gass clan isn't usually quick to throw them in an 'A' off the hop unless they know they have the talent to do so. This filly had a good closing quarter and will gain the rail today for her first lifetime start.

Race 9 1-2-4

Miramonttogo – We're going out on abut of limb here because we know this horse isn't huge on getting his picture taken, but the rookie has the pole position to work with and it is Lobster Carnival week, take our insight if you please but we're playing a hunch..

Four Brass Starz – He is a dangerous match at the 4000 claiming level and has hit the board on five occasions including two wins and a second in his last four starts. With inside control and Barrieau at the lines you can't leave him out that's for sure.

Smiley Bayama – He has entered double digit status but he still continue to turn in solid mile after solid mile, he was on the edges at this level last time out so we will look for him to be in the mix early and find a ground saving trip.

Value Play - Miramonttogo

Race 10 6-4-3

Woodmere Tango – Another filly who has some family behind her – Clare looked to have her ready to go as she didn't look out of place against a couple of away bred. She will however have to work it from the outside post and that might be a tough ask first start.

Magical Mistress – Her mother was the best around during her tenure on the track, and she has turned into a producing broodmare. This filly looked well in rein in her recent qualifier. Hopefully she can mind her manners.

Skycrow – Because she has the most experience on the program she may be worth using at the top of your ticket – Continues to improve with each and every start but the drivers and horses must step up their game when the stakes roll around.

Race 11 1-2-4

Whosurwinner – We've been waiting for the horse who showed up on July 8th for a couple of weeks now and he looks to be back – another look at the same level and a way better post to work from, don't watch him blow up the tote board again tonight.

Textually Active – He delivers best when he is handy or on the front end and as a class dropper here today expect Murphy to be headed right there and he could just play a game of catch me if you can..

Myambrose – We will overlook his last start even though he was only beaten three lengths. He moves over to a much easier condition class then the competition he has been racing as of late too.
