### Race 1 1-2-4

**Mayhem Man** He was a non factor last time out but he drops into a promising spot today with no clear standout and draws the rail. Top call.

**C J Bluefin** Has a start pending which you can use as a guide. He's at the same level today with a favourable post so he's worth considering.

**Saulsbrook Quick** He's in dire need of a confidence boost and with him facing the easiest opposition he has in quite some time, this is a good spot for it.

### Race 2 3-2-4

**Silverhill Misty** None of her rivals come close to matching the times she's been putting up and with her getting away from the top fillies and into a "B" division she's clearly the one to beat.

**Woodmere Sapphire** She's got a good finishing kick and should get spotted well enough to exploit it and if she can avoid a repeat of that miscue two starts back she could be the best of the rest.

**Windemereno harmdone** She's been on the board in three of her last four and is reunited with Kenny so she could add to those totals.

**Most probable** **Silverhill Misty**

### Race 3 7-2-5

**Leda Atomica** She picked up her first win in a couple of years two starts back then followed it up with another solid performance. Draws further outside yet she may be sharp enough to overcome it.

**Mia Lotta** She's got enough gate speed that she may have a fairly easy path to the front from here and with some rated fractions she could be around at the finish.

**Fleurje** She's not a frequent winner but having 18 top three finishes the past two years, the most on the page, gives her some credibility.

### Race 4 4-8-7

**Gigolos Rose** She's been on the board in half her starts this year, has the fastest win time on the page and gets a post advantage over what look to be her main challengers. Top billing.

**Something Royal** She's severely compromised by the draw but she's got a guy at the controls who's more than capable of working out a trip. She's a top contender.

**Zero Stress Nora** She's the most photogenic in the field and while it's hard to say what kind of trip she'll get from out here, the right one makes her dangerous.

### Race 5 2-1-7

**Woodmere Finesse** When you look at the calibre of opposition she's been facing and the fact that she's acquitted herself pretty well, it could be a race for place.

**Ultimate Flyingnun** Steps up slightly but her current form is pretty good and she gets the advantage of rail control. She's a force to be reckoned with.

**Always Reese** She's an unknown and the driver is tba but on the other side of the coin she's cracked the top three in five straight so she's certainly deserving of a look.

### Race 6 6-5-8

**Fiftyshadesofgraci** It took quite a while for her to earn a mark and all she did in the next start was go out and better it. The posts didn't bother her in those two so she's got a shot at a threepeat.

**Howmac Blaze** The top fillies might be a bit too much for her but returning to a "B" division, where she was a bang up second last time could put her right in the hunt.

**Elm Grove Maddy** Her last crack at the "B"s resulted in a win but she had the rail in that one. Terrible post today but it's not impossible if the trip works out.

### Race 7 1-3-6

**Goodmorning Ky** Burned a lot of money last time out but in her defense she never saw the pylons. With the rail today to pretty much eliminate any chance of that happening again she'll be looking to redeem herself.

**Charlottes Style** She doesn't draw inside very often so she'll be looking to take advantage of it today and get spotted on or near the lead. If she does, her chances go way up.

**Lifeinthecountry** There's one positive result in the past month on those lines but look who was driving her in that one and who's at the controls today. Might be worth a shot.

### Race 8 1-4-6

**RES Shabla** How do you go against a filly with four wins from her last five tries, all in 1:56 and she gets the rail to boot? You don't.

**Tobins Terror** She can be a little tardy off the gate by times but she's a strong finisher so some live flow and a cover trip to bring her into it late could put her right in the thick of it.

**Bettim Jackie** Had a bit of a hiccup in her latest but in the two previous starts she'd toyed with her rivals which should tell you how good she can be. Be prepared for a bounce back effort.

### Race 9 5-7-2

**Mach Of Ballykeel** He gets off the gate pretty well so he might be able to set up shop on the front end without being used too hard. If he does, it could be all over.

**Jack Of Clubs** We know nothing about this guy but we can't imagine Garry bringing him all the way down here if he didn't think he'd be competitive. Beware.

**Catch Twenty Two** He's been keeping company with some pretty good ones and never misses a cheque. With some class relief and an ideal post he'll make his presence felt.

**Longshot play** **American Blue Chip**

### Race 10 6-5-2

**Royaltywestho** Bounced back from her first loss of the season with another convincing win last time out. Despite this less than favourable post she'll be hard to deny.

**Woodmere Wyldstyle** She doesn't have a stellar win record but what she does have is an 80% top three record for her career. Pretty hard to leave one out with numbers like that.

**Chocolate Terror** She's been off for three weeks which would normally be cause for concern but it might be just what she needed after that last one. She's a legitimate contender.
