Blackjack House Rules

- Gaming Supervisors decision is **final**.
- Players may double down on two cards that do not total 21. Players can double down for the table minimum but not exceeding their wager.
- Players may split any two cards of equal value up to three times, for a maximum of four separate hands.
- Ace can only be split once, and receive only one card per ace.
- Blackjacks are a point total of 21 using their first two original cards (Ace+10 value card).
 Blackjack is paid at a rate of 3-2.
- The House must hit on a soft 17.
- The House must stand on a hard 17 or more.
- Players can play two betting spots (both wagers must be double the table minimum).
- Players can play a maximum of three betting spots (all three wagers must be five times the table minimum).
- Players must wager in dollar increments (except dealer tip wagers or Insurance wagers).
- Insurance An optional wager available only when the dealer's up card is an ace.
- When the Dealer is showing an Ace, it's the Player's responsibility to request even money.
- Winning insurance wagers will be paid at a rate of 2-1.
- Players cannot hit on Blackjack or 21.
- A card played will never be backed up.
- Dealers are not permitted to give advice to players on the action of their hands.
- Players may not give unsolicited advice to other Players.
- Dealers will pay or take to the table max.
- Players are not permitted to touch the cards at anytime, for any reason.
- Hand signals are required when it is the players turn to act.
- Red Shores reserves the right to prohibit any customer from playing at our venue.
- No Cash or Credit Play.
- Only House chips allowed.
- Food is not allowed at the table.
- Cell Phones and other Electronic Devices are not permitted at the table.
