Flowersonthebeach Draws inside in a compact field so we'd expect him to get away a little better than he has been. With his good late kick and possibly a trip fairly handy the front he's a potential sleeper.

Sports Royalty He's a little too camera shy to put on top but he does have a top three record north of 70% this year so he's certainly worth considering for a piece of it.

Selkirk Echo He was a good fourth last week in his first start at this level and if he can build off that effort he's possible tri material in here.

Flash In The Pang Had a solid third place finish last week and has been keeping company with much better than he meets here. Clearly the one to beat with anything close to his best.

Zingers Laugh He was just a length back last week in a class higher than this so the drop he takes for this one could put him right in the hunt.

Jetta Flys There's not a lot separating the remaining contenders so when in doubt go with the advantage of rail control.

Race 5 2-7-3

Silverhill Buddy A very uncharacteristic eighth place finish last time out but like all horses he's not immune to having one of those days. Be prepared for him to redeem himself in here.

Jetster The outside draw isn't a big deal because he doesn't leave that much anyway. With his come from behind style if there's some pace to make his late rally work he'll be right in the thick of it.
