Race 1 1-5-6

Sun On The Beach First and second in her last two and they were both from outside posts. She gets the rail in here and Marc gets along well with her so we think they get a trip and hit the line first.

Race 2 2-8-4

What A Babe She drops a notch, adds Barrieau and gets a great post to work from tonight. She also has the fastest win time on the page and if the trip works out she could get it all.

Elm Grove Misty Another class dropper who's been right there in her last two starts. Moves outside tonight but with the way she can close don't be too quick to count her out.

Selfie When you look at her stats the past few years all those third place finishes really stand out. She gets a new pilot and with MacPhee at the controls they could rally to get the bronze.

Race 3 6-1-5

Oceanview Echo Brushed to the front last week and never looked back getting that first career win. Coming off that performance she deserves respect and we predict they double up.

Kateanna She's coming off a solid qualifier where she was a winner in 2:01.4. Should be tucked in for most of it and if Donnie can keep her close she could hit the top three in her first for a purse.

Race 4 1-4-3

Mile Hill Wille We went with him last time and he was sent right down the road winning in 1:58.2. He already has six wins on the season and with another good post is a serious contender again tonight.

Cheeky Little Minx She continues to hit the board on a regular basis and proved it again last time out. Has to race from the outside again but it doesn't seem to bother her so we think she gets the show dough.

Race 9 2-3-4
