

Race 1 2-1-3

Lofty Shadow Was on the lead for most of it last week and was just collared in the stretch. The strategy could be the same today and if they do clear he could get that first career win.

Sports Bliss Couldn't deliver as favourite last time but on the bright side he hasn't missed the top three yet. Lands on the rail again and will be covered up so he'll be back on the ticket.

Phantom Shadow That was an excellent effort in his first for a purse finishing second and closing in a solid 29.1. He makes the move to Charlottetown and Bradley is back so we think they get a piece of it.

Race 2 5-6-4

Dusty Lane Milo He's having a terrific season and is nine for nine in top threes including four wins and a record of 2:04.1. We expect Adam to be aggressive off the gate and if they do control it could go wire to wire.

Mr Finlay Ridge He's another one that has a perfect top three record and a sparkling seven wins on his resume. He also has the fastest win time and the most money made so expect another good performance.

A Little Go Go We were really impressed with that start Breeders Crown day where he tracked all the way and was just nipped at the wire. Lands in the mid pack and may get a similar journey so put him in your tickets.

Race 3 4-3-1

Whims Drop Off He's been right there in his last couple and charted in the 1:57-1:58 range. He also gets a slightly better post and should be well positioned so we predict he gets win number three on the season. Saulsbrook Rocky We liked that start two back where he was a bang up third and charted in 1:58. If Earl can keep him close until the top of the stretch he can fly home and nab the deuce.

Southwind Ramsay Check out that chart line in Truro where he was a winner in 1:58.2 closing in 29.2. Gets rail control for this one and adds Campbell so you may want to include.

Race 4 2-1-5

Woodmere Skyroller She's putting up incredible numbers and has ten wins and over \$71,000 in the bank. We're betting David will want to boss it and if they do set up shop on the front end we say six in a row.

Watch Me Dance All she does is finish in the top three and lands on the pylons today. She may be able to draft all the way and if Jason gets that trip we'll call for the silver.

Saulsbrook Ocean Had to come first up in the Breeders Crown final and finished on the edges. Draws post five and has the talent to compete and don't forget she set a track here back in August winning in 1:54.1. Most Probable Woodmere Skyroller

Race 5 1-4-6

Painted Pony Was a four time winner last year but still looking for that first win of 2020. You have to think he's going to get a trip from here and we're predicting Gilles gets him to the wire first.

Jimmy Be Good Already has three wins this season and drops a couple of notches for this start. Lines up in a good spot and we think Corey works out a trip so expect him to be first or second.

Zero Rate Another class dropper who always seems to be in the mix. Back outside but the price will be right and if you're looking for value this could be the one.

Race 6 2-1-4

Mabou Ridge He's put together a tidy season with six wins, over \$33,000 in earnings, and a record of 1:58.1. He could be set up for a pocket ride today and if that's the case there's a good chance he reaches up and wins again. Tequila Tuesday What an awesome effort on Breeders Crown day where Myles sent him right down the road and wired them in 2:00.4. We're wagering the game plan will be the same today and if they do clear we won't be shocked if they go back to back.

Go With Her All she does is hit the board every start and proved it again last time. She's had a dynamite season and with consistency like that we aren't about to leave her out.

Race 7 3-2-5

Messier Seelster Great effort last out where he was a strong second to Legendary Ron and closed in a snappy 28.3. He seems to be back on his game and if he does that again he'll get the gold this time.

Tempo Seelster Moves up a notch for this one but the good news is he draws inside. Should be tucked in for most of it and he can still scoot home so be prepared for a good result.

Harbourlite Jerry Second and third in his last two and now moves back up the class ladder for this assignment. He'll likely be coming from the back but could come calling late and grab the show dough.

Race 8 5-1-3

Streakazana She had a good run at Three Rivers before returning to PEI. We liked the way she raced in the Breeders Crown final and in a compact field like this she could go one better today.

Red Dirt Star She's had a very good year with six wins, a record of 1:56.1 and over \$48,000 in purse money. It looks like Gilles will get to call the shots and if they do get to the front will be hard to track down.

Gotta Love Cabot First, second, and third in her last three starts and lands in a prime time spot today. She should get a good journey from here and is a solid choice to round out the triactor.

Race 9 5-1-3

Windemere Frank That was some effort Breeders Crown day when he was sent to the point and was on top for every step of it winning in 1:57.2. We predict David will be firing off the wings and don't be surprised if they go coast to coast again.

The Big Chase Gets back inside and will be protecting the rail today. He looks to be in line for a super trip and if it works out he could get the silver and serve up some value too.

Windemere Ryan Already has four wins this year and approaching \$30,000 in prize money. Take a look at that start two back where he was a winner and closed in a brisk 27.3 so that's why he's back on our ticket.

Race 10 7-2-3

Rockin Indy He shook loose late last week and just missed in a tight finish. It's hard to win from post seven and this is a good group but we think he gets a trip and rewards the bettors as well.

Jetster Big effort last time when came first up and cruised to victory in 1:56.1. Moves up slightly but that was a confidence builder and Campbell returns so we think they hit the podium again.

Sports Royalty Takes a minor dip and hasn't missed the board in his last three starts. Should be in line for a favourable trip and with the way he can close could add another top three to his totals.

Race 11 6-2-4

Mr Kelly He's been to the winners circle seven times this year and has the fastest win time on the page. It won't be easy from out here but he can fly home and may get it all at the wire.

Tobins Rebel What an amazing season this guy is having with nine wins, a record of 1:54.3 and over \$66,000 in earnings. He also gets back inside and with Barrieau in the bike looks like a must use.

Little Manny He's been on the fringes in his last few but has had a solid season overall. If you don't want to play the chalk and are searching for a price this could be a good choice.

Race 12 6-2-1

Time To Dance He's been on an incredible roll and winning at various tracks across the Maritimes. He's also been assigned post six but we think he overcomes it and finds the winners circle again.

Rose Run Quest Big time effort from post six last out where he fired home in 28.1 and was a winner in 1:54.1. Gets a great spot to work from today and will get a trip so he could double up.

The Rev He was right there last time missing by a whisker in a blanket finish. He's going to get a smooth journey and has been sharp since returning to the Maritimes so expect him to have a say before it's over. Value Play Screen Test

Race 13 2-3-6

Three Truths Drops a couple of levels and gets another good post for this start. Marc is back in the sulky and we expect him to be on or near the lead at the start and finish.

J K Express He's starting to round back into form and just wired them in 1:57.1. Coming off that performance he deserves respect and has a big shot to get win number six on the year.

Bank Shot Hanover Just missed the top three last time but not that far away either. He gets a new driver and we're betting Brodie will map out a trip and hit the ticket.
