

**Race 1 1-7-3**

**Howmacrivercruiser** She's razor sharp right now and has three straight second place finishes. Lands on the rail and is going to get a trip so we say she gets her first win of 2020.

**Lock Her Up** She's settled in nicely on PEI and has hit the board in every start. Back outside for this one but we think she overcomes it and is first or second again.

**I Can Do It** Just missed the top three last time finishing fourth but closed pretty well over an off track. Adds dash lead Campbell and the price will be right so we'll call for the show spot.

**Race 2 5-1-3**

**Southern Heart** Take a look at that start three back where she came first up and was a going away winner on a sloppy track. She gets the same class, same driver, similar post and maybe the same result.

**Akrotiri** She was scratched out of her last start but is putting together a nice season. She'll likely be coming from the back but look at all those second place finishes...could get another one today.

**Top Of Her Trade** That was an excellent debut last week where she was a winner and fired home in 29.2. Gets another good spot to work from and Taylor returns so they're back on our ticket.

**Race 3 1-6-7**

**Clare Hall Hanover** Made an early break and took herself out of it last start. She does have four wins this year and drops a notch in here so be prepared for a big time bounce back.

**Toonietina** Finished on the fringes last time but has been racing well for the past month. Moves outside and gets a new pilot and we're confident David maps out a trip into the top three.

**Windmerenohardone** Hasn't had much to cheer about lately but up against some pretty good company. Drops down for this assignment and with the way she can scoot home we have to include.

**Race 4 4-6-5**

**Winter Blast** Almost got there last week when he can first over and was a game second to I C True Grit. Back in the mid pack and gets the same class so we think he goes one better today.

**Hemingway** When you look at his chart lines he's always in contention week in and week out. Takes a slight drop and the last time he raced this level was a winner...could happen again today.

**Melanies Magic** Check out those two starts in Summerside where he was first and second with Barrieau driving. Gilles is at the controls today and they get along well so it may be wise to put them in your tickets.

**Race 5 5-3-1**

**Tobinator** He's been living on the edges in his last few but not that far away last time. We're betting Corey will be aggressive off the wings and if they do clear could score win number four on the season.

**Three Truths** Was scratched out of his last start and hasn't raced since October 31st. He has good early speed and should be well spotted and don't forget he has the fastest win time on the page so we'll call for the deuce.

**Sunny Beach** He's missed the ticket in all three PEI starts but does have three wins this year. We're playing a bit of a hunch and he will be covered up so we think they get the show dough.

**Race 6 7-6-1**

**J K Cowboy** We went with him last time and he was oh so close to winning just getting nipped at the wire. Second and third in his last two starts so if you like playing trends he could be sitting on a win.

**Agood Time To Rock** He's raced well since arriving on PEI and proved it again last time. The partnership with Kenny has worked out great and with the way he can close we think they're part of it again.

**Egamer** Pretty good effort last time where he tracked all the way and nabbed the bronze. Takes a slight hike but will be tucked in for most of it so he's a solid option to round out the tri.

**Race 7 5-6-4**

**Windmeredontuworry** Got into an early speed duel last week and had to settle for a fourth place finish. Remains at the same level and we'll see what Marc decides to do but we predict they rebound with a win.

**Daisy River** When you look at her stats she's put together an excellent year with four wins and a record of 1:58.1. Draws post six today but we're wagering Jason works out a trip and gets a big piece of it.

**Labero** Finished on the edges last time but remember it was an off track. He's had success at this level in the past and Gilles is back in the sulky so don't be too quick to count them out.

**Race 8 8-1-2**

**Mrs Dragonfire** Only has one win this year but when you look at her lines she's right there every week. It's hard to win from post eight but with the way she can fly home could reach up and grab the gold late.

**Good Luck Kathy** We liked that start two back where she drafted all the way and was a bang up second. Lands on the pylons and if David gets that trip again they're back on the podium.

**Lyons Jennielee** Drops a few notches and lands in a prime time spot. We think Myles will be aiming for the front and if she does set up shop on the point they'll have a large say in the outcome.

**Race 9 3-7-1**

**Tempo Seelster** Take a closer look at that line from last week where he was fifth in a very tight finish. Gets a better post this time and Kenny knows him well so we think they hit the wire first.

**Clever Thing** He's on an absolute roll right now and hasn't been out of the top three in his last ten starts. Has to move back outside but with the way he's racing we aren't about to leave him out.

**Zero Rate** We've said it before he always seems to be in the mix no matter what post he draws. The good news is he's on the rail this time and should get a smooth journey so get ready for a good result.

**Value Play** **Painted Pony**

**Race 10 3-5-4**

**Dreamfair Zenfire** She hasn't raced in a month but is having an incredible year with 11 wins and a record of 1:54.2! She also loves the front end and we think Adam will be calling the shots all the way to the winners circle.

**Arc Light** She's also been away for a month but has put together an outstanding campaign. She'll likely be coming from off the pace and is iron tough so expect her to be a factor at the finish.

**Woodmere Skyroller** What an awesome three year old season she is having with 11 wins and a record of 1:54.3. She hasn't looked out of place against older competition either and we expect more of the same today.

**Race 11 5-2-8**

**Smart Official** Might be the sharpest horse on PEI right now and was a winner again last time. This is a good group but with the way he is rolling along we have to put him back on top.

**Creepin** He's missed the top three in his last two starts but was a winner on November 15th. Gets back inside for this one and we think he might get a trip and provide some value as well.

**Pillage And Burn** He's another one who hasn't been off the board in his last ten starts. It won't be easy from out here but with the way he's racing don't be shocked if he's first, second or third.

**Race 12 9-8-6**

**Adkins Hanover** Drops down and gets the back tier for this start. He looks to have the step to go with these and check out those closing panels so we predict Ambyr gets him there today.

**Theycalledmedude** Excellent effort last out where he was a winner and closed in a snappy 29.3. He has to race from the fence this week but if Kenny can keep him close he could come calling late and double up.

**Arrived Late** He's missed a cheque in his last two both at higher levels. Drops down and remember he does have four wins this year so if you're searching for a price this could be the one.

**Race 13 7-4-2**

**Southwind Ion** Drops out of the Open Mares and the last time she raced this level was a winner in 1:56.2. She already has six wins in 2020 and now adds Barrieau so we think they could surprise.

**Therealdeal** She was scratched sick last time but prior to that had been racing pretty well. There's a strong chance David will want to boss it and if they do clear could be hard to reel in.

**Miss Kabana** We loved that start three back where she was tucked in the entire way and was a winner. Looks to be in line for a similar trip and if she gets it will add another top three to her totals.

**Race 14 4-5-2**

**Screen Test** He was sent to the front last week and controlled every step of it only to be collared at the wire. We think Corey may try the same strategy today only this time they could go all the way.

**The Rev** That was some effort last week when closed in a brisk 26.4 to get it all at the finish. He's had a fantastic return to the Maritimes and is riding a three race win streak so be prepared for another good performance.

**Rockin Indy** Got a perfect two hole ride last week and took advantage of it getting up late to nip Pillage And Burn. Has to move up but he looks to have his swagger back and that means trouble for his opposition.

**Race 15 1-2-5**

**Miss Sangria** That was some performance last time where she cleared past three quarters and was an easy winner in 1:57.4. Coming of a performance like that she's deserves respect and could go back to back.

**Jens Credit** We've said it before she's put together a tidy season and was a winner two back in 1:57.4. Remains at the same level and looks to be in line for a nice trip so we'll call for the silver.

**Tell Me Why** When you look at her summary she's had a pretty good season. Moves up slightly and if Corey has her handy at the top of the lane she could sweep them late.
