**Card Swap** He's a newcomer to PEI and did a have two victories last year including one at Western Fair in 1:57.3. Lines up outside but looks to have the step and we're confident David works out a trip and nabs the deuce.

**Jadensmagicsteel** When you look at his numbers he put together a tidy summary in 2020. He got it done from post six in his qualifier and now lands on the cones so get ready for a good result.

#### Race 5 6-5-3

Clare Hall Hanover She's coming off a solid season in 2020 which included five wins and a record of 1:58.2. Draws outside but Barrieau is back and he's had success with her in the past so we'll put them on top.
