**Race 2 3-5-1**

**Majian Tango** We went with him last week and he raced great just getting nipped at the very end. The good news is he moves to post three and is knocking on the door for a win...we say tonight.

**Mile Hill Willie** He hasn't had many starts this year but that qualifier on October 9th jumps off the page. Just a reminder he did win eight times last season and can still scoot home, so we say first or second.

**Incredible Two** Twelve for thirteen in top three's and just missed by a whisker last time out. Lands on the pylons and there's no doubt Kenny will have her on the front foot so they're a good choice to complete the tri.

**Race 3 3-6-4**

**Gracies Glory** She's off to an excellent start in her early racing career and was a going away winner last time. Lines up in a prime-time spot and Dowling is back so there's a strong chance they double up.

**Race 5 1-3-4**

**Girl In A Tavern** She's rolling along right now and has hit the ticket in five straight starts. She also gets the pole position and those closing panels are snappy so expect to see them smiling for the camera.
