Race 2 4-6-1

Neptune Seelster Went a huge trip last week reeling in the pace setter and cruising to victory in 1:59.3. It was an excellent trip and with that in mind you may want to put him in the early Pick 4.

Woodmere Sheldon He was on the edges in his first start of the spring meet but was charted in 1:59.2. Lands on the cones and will be tucked in so he's a good choice to complete the triactor.

Race 3 4-5-3

Cowboy Logic He's had an excellent career since arriving on the Island and if you need more proof take a look at the stats. Lines up in a prime-time position and there's a good chance he starts the year with a win.

Selkirk Echo Had to race from post eight but to his credit rallied late to secure the bronze. Gets a better post to work from and all those second place finishes really stand out, so that's where we'll place him in here.

Silverhill Buddy He's been knocking on the door in his last two and was just nipped both times. Bumps up the classer ladder and Dowling returns so we think they land on the podium.

Race 4 2-6-3

Justcallmedoc We had him for part of the ticket last time and he raced great scoring in 1:57.3. It looks like he's going to get another nice journey and just might go back-to-back.

Bonitas Sunshine Another one who raced well from the fence and just missed hitting the top three. Slightly better post and he could land on the scene late and make some noise.

Middleton Terror He missed the ticket in his spring debut but was still charted in 1:58.1. Don't forget he did win four times last season and is going to get better trip so we're going to include.

Race 5 6-1-5

Screen Test He's been battling outside posts for the past few weeks and was up against the bearcats. Takes a slight dip and this is a good group, but we think he returns to his winning ways.

Race 9 5-1-2
