Conditions:

1. All events conducted under the rules and regulations of the Atlantic Provinces Harness Racing Commission, Standardbred Canada and host tracks as listed: Exhibition Park, Truro Raceway, Red Shores at Summerside Raceway and Red Shores at the Charlottetown Driving Park.
2. These are all Invitational Events and the Race Secretary at each host track will be responsible for inviting starters and to post conditions for each individual event.
 - a. Horses must have a MINIMUM of TWO (2) pari-mutuel starts in the Maritimes in 2022 at date of declaration for events from the Governor's Plate onward.
 - b. The Preferred 1 class will not be called for in conflict with any of the events listed above.
3. Participants will be awarded points based on the order of finish in each invitational event they start:
 - a. First place through fifth place will be awarded the following points respectively 7-5-4-3-2.
 - b. All other starters, sixth place on, will be awarded one (1) point for starting.
4. To be eligible for the Premier's Cup, horses will have to have competed in one of the events above in a MINIMUM of TWO (2) Maritime Provinces.
5. Horses with the minimum two (2) Maritime starts prior to August 8th, 2022, and who declare in for the Gold Cup and Saucer Trials will be awarded three (3) points towards the Atlantic Invitational Series standings.
6. The Top eight (8) points earners will be invited to the Atlantic Invitational Series Final, Premier's Cup.
7. In the event any of the top points earners are unable to participate, the next highest points earner(s) will be invited.
8. The winning Owner, Trainer and Driver in the Premier's Cup will be presented awards by the Premier of Prince Edward Island.
