CONDITIONS:

1. All events conducted under the rules and regulations of the Atlantic Provinces Harness Racing Commission, Standardbred Canada and Red Shores.
2. Declarations due by date and time posted on the weekly condition sheet.
3. All races will be at a distance of one (1) mile unless otherwise stated.
4. All starting positions shall be drawn electronically using the electronic draw system provided by Standardbred Canada.
5. Purse distribution:
 - a. 5 or more starters: 50 — 25 — 12 — 8 — 5%;
 - b. 4 starters: 50 — 25 — 15 — 10%;
 - c. 3 starters: 60 — 30 — 10%;
 - d. 2 starters: 65 — 35%;
 - e. 1 starter: 100%
6. Minimum of six (6) entries are required to fill this event. Separate divisions will be held for mares and horses/geldings in all legs.
7. Horses must race in both preliminary legs to be eligible for the final.
8. If there is more than one division of the legs, each division will race for 100% of the advertised purse.
9. Finalist will be determined by money earned in preliminary legs.
10. Red Shores reserves the option to host a consolation. In the event that there is a consolation, horses that earn enough money in the series to qualify for the finals will not be permitted to race in the consolation. In the event there is no consolation, Red Shores reserves the right to have 9 starters in the final of the series.
11. In the event of a tie, entry will be selected by lot for consolation/final.
12. Red Shores and PEI Harness Racing Industry Association reserves the right to amend conditions, rearrange programs and in the event that on the day of the scheduled race, the operation of races cannot be held for any reason whatsoever, they reserve the right to reschedule the race to an APHRC approved future race date.
13. Red Shores Shores accepts no responsibility or liability for any accident, loss, or damage, which may occur on their property as a result of these, or any races.
14. All owners, trainers, drivers must be members in good standing with the APHRC and Standardbred Canada.

15. All horses must meet the qualifying standards of Red Shores
16. Should there be horses with common ownership; Red Shores reserves the right to uncouple horses for pari-mutuel purposes as per APHRC Rule 206.
