DECLARATION DATE: Declarations for each leg of the series close at the date & time listed on the weekly condition sheet. Horses MUST declare into each leg of the series.

NO STARTING OR NOMINATION FEE

In the event there is enough entries to fill both a horse/gelding and mares event, entries will be separated by sex.

- Declarations close at the time and date posted on the weekly condition sheet. Those DECLARING horses to these
 events are responsible for eligibility. ELIGIBILITY DETERMINED BY STARTS AND MONEY EARNINGS AS OF
 NOVEMBER 26th, 2024.
- 2. NO nomination and starting fees.
- 3. Minimum of Ten (10) DECLARATIONS are required to fill this EVENT. If less than 10 DECLARATIONS are received the event may proceed at the discretion of Red Shores.
- 4. Purse distribution:
 - a. 5 or more starters: 50 25 12 8 5%.
 - b. 4 starters: 50 25 15 10%.
 - c. 3 starters: 60 30 10%.
 - d. 2 starters: 65 35%.
 - e. 1 starter: 100%
- 5. Horses not earning purse money in any leg will receive the following hook up fees:
 - a. Leg 1 will receive \$100 hook up fee.
 - b. Leg 2 will receive \$125 hook up fee.
 - c. Leg 3 will receive a \$150 hook up fee.
- 6. All races will be at a distance of one (1) mile unless otherwise stated.
- 7. Post starting positions shall be drawn electronically using the electronic draw system provided by Standardbred Canada
- 8. All events conducted under the rules and regulations of the Atlantic Provinces Harness Racing Commission, Standardbred Canada.
- 9. Red Shores reserves the right to rearrange programs and in the event that on the day of the scheduled race, the operation of races cannot be held for any reason whatsoever, they reserve the right to reschedule the race to an APHRC approved future race date.
- 10. Red Shores accepts no responsibility or liability for any accident, loss, or damage, which may occur on their property as a result of these, or any races.
- 11. All owners, trainers, drivers must be members in good standing with the APHRC and Standardbred Canada.
- 12. All horses must meet the qualifying standards of Red Shores.
- 13. Should there be horses with common ownership, Red Shores reserves the right to uncouple horses for pari-mutuel purposes as per APHRC Rule 206.
