Conditions:

- 1. All events and race conditions will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the Atlantic Provinces Harness Racing Commission, Standardbred Canada and Red Shores.
- Nominations for the first leg are due at Red Shores Race Office by 3:00 p.m. Friday, July 25th, 2025. Those nominating and declaring horses to compete in these events are responsible for eligibility. There is no nomination fee.
- 3. Declarations for all legs and the final close at the time and date posted on the weekly condition sheet.
- 4. Sponsors added money will be added to the final.
- 5. All nominations are subject to Red Shores rules and policies at time of racing.
- 6. All races will be at a distance of one (1) mile unless otherwise stated.
- 7. All starting positions shall be drawn electronically using the electronic draw system provided by Standardbred Canada
- 8. Purse distribution:
 - a. 5 or more starters: 50 25 12 8 5%;
 - b. 4 starters: 50 25 15 10%;
 - c. 3 starters: 60 30 10%;
 - d. 2 starters: 65 35%;
 - e. 1 starter: 100%.
- Competing horses must be owned at time of nomination and declaration by a resident
 of the Atlantic Provinces and maintain ownership by a resident of the Atlantic Provinces
 while racing in the series.
- 10. If leased, both lessee and lessor must be residents of the Atlantic Provinces at time of nomination, declaration, and competition in each component of the series.

- 11. To be eligible for the final, an entry must have competed in at least two (2) legs of the series.
- 12. Estimated purse of \$6,500 per Leg if one division. Final estimated at \$15,000.
- 13. Minimum of four (4) nominations are required to fill this series.
- 14. If more than nine (9) entries are received for any leg, there will be two divisions.
- 15. The top eight (8) money earners from the legs will race in the final, the next top money earners (9th up to 16th) will race in the consolation.
- 16. There must be a minimum of five (5) entries for the consolation. In the event there are fewer than (5) entries, Red Shores reserves the right to cancel the consolation.
- 17. In the event there is no consolation Red Shores reserves the right to have 9 starters in the final of the series.
- 18. In the event that there is a consolation, horses that earn enough money in the series to qualify for the finals cannot race in the consolation.
- 19. In the event of a tie, the entry will be selected by lot.
- 20. Red Shores reserves the right to refuse any nomination, return fees, rearrange programs and in the event that on the day of the scheduled race, the operation of races cannot be held for any reason whatsoever, they reserve the right to reschedule the race to an APHRC approved future race date or cancel it in which case all monies paid will be refunded.
- 21. A declaration for this event is an agreement to all the above terms and conditions.
- 22. Red Shores accepts no responsibility or liability for any accident, loss, or damage, which may occur on their property as a result of these, or any races.
- 23. Red Shores reserves the right to make any changes to conditions and schedule they deem necessary.
- 24. All owners, trainers, drivers must be members in good standing with the APHRC and Standardbred Canada.
- 25. All horses must meet the qualifying standards of Red Shores.
