Event for 2 year old pacing fillies to be raced at Red Shores Racetrack and Casino at the Charlottetown Driving Park on Friday, August 14th, 2026

NOMINATION FEES: \$150 due Tuesday, June 23rd, 2026, by 9:00 a.m.

Payable by cash or cheque to Red Shores at the Red Shores Race Office (CDP).

No Starting Fee for this event

DECLARATION DATE: Tuesday, August 11th, 2026 by 9 A.M. AST

PURSE: \$8,000

ELIGIBILITY:

- Two-year-old pacing fillies that are 100% owned by PEI residents (see definition below) at time of nomination, declaration, and for the duration of the event.
- Two-year-old fillies must also meet one of the following criteria in addition to being 100% owned by PEI residents:
 - a) non-maritime sired, **or**
 - b) non-maritime foaled, **or**
 - c) non-maritime sired and non-maritime foaled

Conditions:

1. All events and race conditions will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the Maritime Provinces Harness Racing Commission and Standardbred Canada.
2. Nominations close at the time and date posted above. Those **NOMINATING** horses to this event are responsible for eligibility.
3. **Competing horses must be 100% owned at the time of nomination and declaration by a resident of Prince Edward Island and maintain ownership by a resident of Prince Edward Island for the duration of the event. RESIDENT: A resident of PEI is a person whose primary residence is on PEI. Competing horses must also meet one of the criteria listed under bullet 2 in the eligibility requirements.**
4. The race will be at a distance of 1 mile unless otherwise stated.
5. All starting positions shall be drawn electronically using the electronic draw system provided by Standardbred Canada
6. Purse distribution:
 - a. 5 or more starters: 50 — 25 — 12 — 8 — 5%;
 - b. 4 starters: 50 — 25 — 15 — 10%;

- c. 3 starters: 60 — 30 — 10%;
 - d. 2 starters: 65 — 35%;
 - e. 1 starter: 100%.
7. All nominating fees will be added to the purse. Should conditions beyond the control of Red Shores prevent the racing of this event, Red Shores reserves the right to declare off the event and distribute the nomination fees to the current eligibles, or to transfer the event to another date, or to another track, or to do both.
 8. Red Shores reserves the right to make any changes to conditions and schedule they deem fit.
 9. All owners, trainers, drivers must be members in good standing with the MPHRC and Standardbred Canada.
 10. All horses must meet the qualifying standards of Red Shores and the Atlantic Standardbred Breeders Association.
 11. Should there be horses with common ownership; Red Shores reserves the right to uncouple horses for pari-mutuel purposes as per MPHRC Rule 206.
 12. Red Shores accepts no responsibility or liability for any accident, loss, or damage, which may occur on their property as a result of these, or any races.
